

The following applies to international applicants from non-EU (European Union) and non-EEA (European Economic Area - Iceland, Lichtenstein, Norway) countries with a foreign university entrance qualification. Application to the Master's degree programme fast track having a standard duration of two semesters commences with an online registration.

As part of the application process, specific documents must be submitted prior to the deadline, i.e. by January 15th for summer semester and July 15th for winter semester entry, respectively. Application process

All applicants please start by

1. completing the [online application form](#),
2. on completion follow the request to download the form,
3. print it out and sign it,
4. include the required documents given on page 3,
5. and send it to the postal address given on the form's frontpage.

Selection procedure

The selection process is a two step procedure:

1. In the course of study preceding the Master's programme, i.e. Bachelor of Science degree in physics having a standard duration of study of four years, at least 210 ECTS points and an average grade of 1.9 in the German grading system must be demonstrated. The average grade is converted into a score on a scale of 7 to 15.
2. This is followed by an invitation to a selection interview in which the competencies for successful admission to the Master's programme, motivation and language skills in the context of physics are assessed. Competencies are scored on a scale of 0 to 10, with motivation providing up to 4 additional points.

If the the sum of points scored in step 1 plus those obtained in step 2 is greater or equal to 16, admission to the Master's degree programme will be granted.

Selection interviews

The dates for interviews are not yet fixed. Your invitation to an interview will be sent to you electronically, i.e. via email, only.

The online application portal and forms are available during the application period only. The course of study preceding the Master's programme, usually a Bachelor's degree, must have been finalised at the beginning of the desired semester of entry at the latest.
